

## Q1 On a scale of 1 to 5 (where 1 is not important, and 5 is very important), how important is it to have a Community Pub in Middleton St George?





#### Q2 Do you support the community acquiring Platform 1/Fighting Cocks?





## Q3 If our local pub was opened/saved/run by the community in Middleton St George, would any member of your household use it?





#### Q4 What kind of catering would you like to see from the pub?








